There are moments in life that change you forever. For me, that moment came in the front seat of a car while I was racing my grandson, Ahmad "Captain Poodaman" Butler, to the hospital for help. By this time, he was paralyzed from the waist down, and blood was slowly dripping from his nose. I did not believe he would survive the car ride.

But at that moment, when I was filled with fear and helplessness, Ahmad, as always, was filled with courage and love, and in his fighting spirit, he looked up at me and said, "Grandmom, when I become a grownup, I'm going to be a Police Officer. Do you think I'll be a good police officer, Grandmom? Do you think I will help a lot of people?"

My heart smiled and shattered at the same time. I knew my "Poodadoo" would forever be a six-year-old. But I looked at him, holding back tears, and said, "Yes, baby, you will be a great Police Officer."

The Ahmad Butler Foundation was born that day, born from a silent promise I made to my dying grandson, which has become the heartbeat of this Foundation.

In 2024, the heartbeat echoed in powerful ways. One being Philadelphia Police Commissioner Kevin J. Bethel, deeming Ahmad "Captain Poodaman" Butler an honorary Police Officer for the Philadelphia Police Department, along with 25 other Superhero Kids.

Our mission lives on, fueled by Ahmad's spirit, driven by the fierce love of the families we serve, support from the community, and local and national businesses, and our belief that every child deserves joy, respect, and a fighting chance. In 2024, thanks to your support, we have positively impacted the lives of over 5,000 people.

I am FOREVER grateful to everyone who lifted me onto their shoulders when I was unable to stand on my own. FOREVER grateful to those who wiped my tears with words of encouragement and pushed me forward with their belief in me. FOREVER grateful for all of your support during our most challenging times and for helping to build something beautiful out of unimaginable pain. ## 1MFM

The 1Million Families March for the Cure of Childhood Cancer, our annual event held during Childhood Cancer Awareness Month. ABF hosts a string of events to support families diagnosed with pediatric cancer, advocate for increased funding, raise awareness of the impacts, and fundraise for our programs.

### **Fight With Lights**

A global landmark illumination program created to heighten awareness of the impacts of pediatric cancer while being a show of support for families amid their battles.

## The Digital Learning Program (DLP)

Created to ensure that children can continue to receive a quality education while hospitalized.

Through our Love of Learning Program (LLP), we donate devices to underprivileged children we serve, enabling them to participate in their school's curriculum during at-home recovery.




